WALK & PLAY

Telham Playing Field, Battle TN33 0TQ - There is a small play area with swings, slide, climbing apparatus, etc. for young children within a large wildflower meadow with extensive views. Please note that there is no access by car. Dogs must be kept on a lead.

Coronation Gardens Play Area, Battle TN33 0DN - The play area, located on a large recreation ground, includes a zip-wire, a toddlers' and young children's play unit and a 4m climbing net for older children, as well as swings, a see-saw and a roundabout.

Battle Recreation Ground, North Trade Road, Battle TN33 0HB - As well as senior and junior football pitches, there are tennis courts, a multi-use games area, a table tennis table, a petanque terrain and a cycle pump track. There is also a play castle, an adventure play area and swings. Gym equipment is also available. Dogs must be kept on a lead. Battle Health Pathway is an all-weather track for walkers, runners, cyclists and push chairs too.


